



4.2 – Junior Board Allocation

1. Introduction

Scarboro Surf Life Saving Club has allocated funding to our junior committee to purchase boards for use by junior members. This policy outlines how these boards are to be used appropriately and their condition maintained.

2. Objectives

The objectives of this document are to;

- Ensure junior members and their parents are aware of their obligation when using a club board.
 - Outline the requirements to be eligible to be allocated a board.
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3. Definition

Board – Fibreglass Malibu board

Club – Scarboro Surf Lifesaving Club

Club Member – The junior member and their parents/guardian

Junior – Members under 14 years of age as at 30 Sept

Training Sessions – Club organised training sessions

4. Junior Board Allocation

To be eligible to have a board allocated to the Club Member, the following criteria must be fulfilled;

- Attend training sessions at least weekly or as specified by the Area Captain or Board Coach
- Show skills that demonstrate control of a board (as determined by the coach in charge)
- Attend all carnivals throughout the season
- Be available to compete in the State Championships
- Have an appropriate place to store board at home
- Have appropriate method of transporting board (roof racks or large car)

Parents will be required to sign an agreement that outlines all requirements for the use and care of the board.
