1.2 – Current Membership Fees

1. Introduction

This policy outlines the membership fees for the coming season, all fees become due for payment at the AGM on 24 June 2016; all building access cards will be deactivated at this time for non-financial members. For details on the requirements for each membership category and the facilities available to members in those categories then please refer to Policy 1.1 Membership Categories.

This Policy aligns to Clause 7.1 of the Constitution.

2. Categories & Fees

Category	Fee	Explanation
General	\$100	Category for parent members and those members not wishing to patrol but be involved on a social basis.
Nipper Under 6 & Under 7	\$100 per child	Youngest age for joining. Age category based on age at 30 th September, birth certificate must be sighted for all new members.
Junior Under 8 to Under 14 inclusive	\$130 per child	Age category based on age at 30 th September, birth certificate must be sighted for all new members. Board bond required for U11-U14 competing members allocated a Club board.
Cadet Under 15	\$130 per child	Junior patrolling member after completion of their Surf Rescue Certificate. Can compete in Senior carnivals provided they hold their SRC and complete their patrol hours requirements.
Under 17	\$130 per member	Active patrolling members after the completion of their Bronze Medallion. Can compete in Senior carnivals provided they hold their BM and complete their patrol hours requirements.
Under 19	\$130 per member	Active patrolling members after the completion of their Bronze Medallion. Can compete in Senior carnivals provided they hold their BM and complete their patrol hours requirements.
Active Senior	\$150 per member	Active patrolling members after the completion of their Bronze Medallion. Can compete in Senior carnivals provided they hold their BM and complete their patrol hours requirements

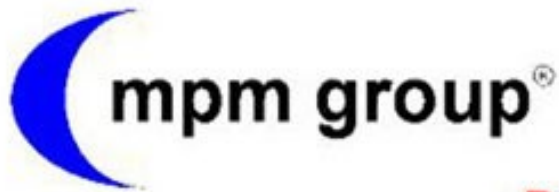


1.2 – Current Membership Fees

Category	Fee	Explanation
Active Reserve & Long Service	\$150 per member	As approved by the Beach Operations Committee based on length of service and contribution.
Bronze Medallion Course Fee	\$60 per trainee	Course fee is in addition to membership fee and covers resources and assessment of candidates.
Club Access Card	\$20 per card	Provides access to Club facilities based on your membership category.
Competition Fee	\$50 – Open \$30 - Juniors	Applicable to all competitors and payable prior to the first carnival entered for the season. This fee covers all carnivals for all disciplines for the 2016/2017 season. State & Australian Championship Fees are not included in this fee and must be paid separately upon entry to the events.
Patrol Rebate	\$50	Provided to Cadet, Under 17 & 19 and Active Senior patrolling members that complete all required patrol commitments for the entire 2016/2017 season. Rebate will be applied to the following season's fees.



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
