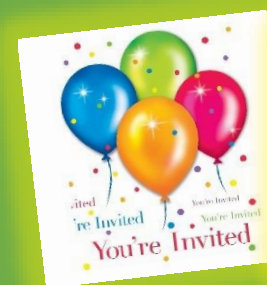

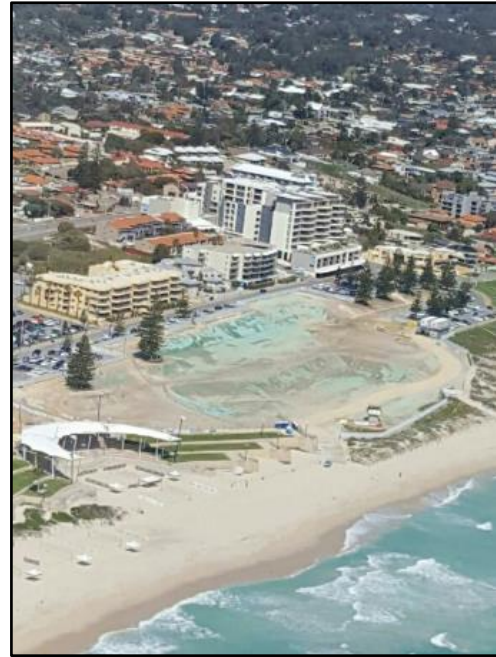

2016/17 Preliminary Evaluations

Preliminary evaluations are to ensure that Nipper participants taking part in the program for the coming season are fit and able to meet the requirements of the SLSWA Nipper Education program and must be conducted prior to the commencement of formalised activities. In order to alleviate the process for completing preliminary evaluations, clubs may now utilise third-party sign offs for nipper participants, provided they are from a registered learn to swim provider.



For participants that have not completed any of the corresponding awards from the following recognised programs, a Preliminary Evaluation MUST be conducted. Preliminary evaluations can be conducted in either the pool or the ocean, but please note that all ocean based evaluations must be conducted in accordance with the water safety requirements as set out in SLSA 1.01a – Water Safety Procedure document.

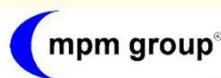
"Polar Bear" swims have finished for the SEASON! The **Summer Season Swims** are starting this weekend at 9:30am
