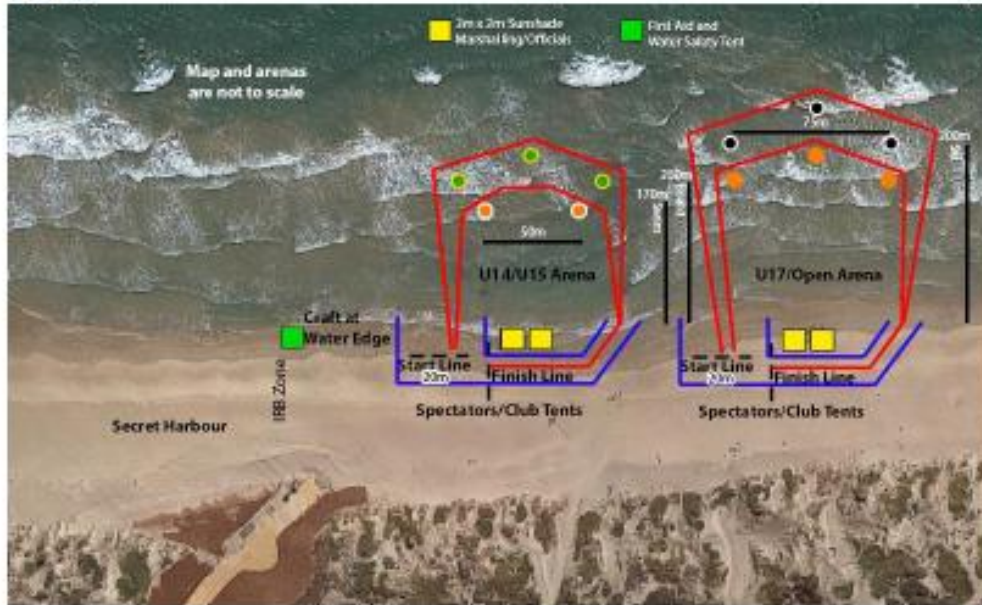

Course:



Event Procedure

Run start, run finish. Handlers will be required for each board and ski competitor. To avoid any potential damage to craft, competitors are encouraged to drag their craft up onto the sand before commencing their run to the finish. Handlers will be required to be a member of any SLSWA club and wear a competition cap.



Surf Rowers Series Round 2 – North Point, Mullaloo Beach
Saturday 19 November 2016

Entries: Entries will close Tuesday 15 November, 11pm before event.

After close of entries, heat draws will be created on Wednesday and distributed to clubs Thursday. Therefore, clubs are encouraged to ensure all crew information is accurate at this time and no late entries will be accepted after 5pm Thursday.

- The minimum age to compete in Surf Boat races is 16 years as at the day of competition.
- Only Stage 2 and Stage 3 Sweeps are permitted to race in these events.
- If the Surf Hazard Rating (SHR) assessment returns a result of 13 or higher, helmets will be required for all competitors and only Stage 3 sweeps can participate. Helmets must be in club colours or be covered in a club cap.
