Juniors to Seniors:

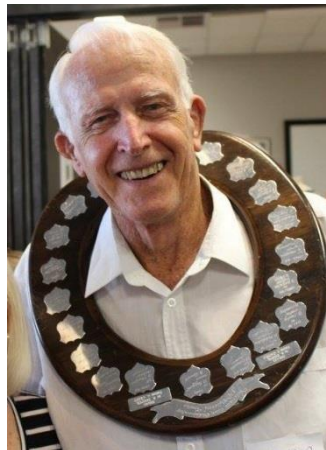

Sausage Sizzle:

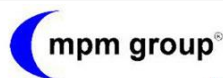
